### Introduction:

The PDF Timetable is a downloadable Timetable for the Windows PC that can additionally be viewed from a Web browser. The platform can be viewed online or downloaded to a user's PC for offline viewing.

The PDF Timetable Platform requires Adobe Acrobat Viewer to be installed on the user's computer. The application is free and is pre installed on the vast majority of PC's sold.

### Tech specs:

The PDF Timetable Platform is compatible with any computer using Adobe Acrobat Reader version 3.0 or later.

### PDF Timetable Platform

The PDF Timetable Platform is accessed via a Web link and loads Adobe Acrobat Reader to view the PDF Timetable Platform. PDF Timetable Platform is compatible with both Windows and Macintosh computers.

The PDF Timetable can be viewed on line, downloaded to the user's computer or printed to the user's printer.

The PDF is similar in many respects to a printed timetable, however the file is not sent to the printer. Thus the range of SSIM schedule data fields that can be displayed, is based upon preference.

In addition to displaying SSIM data fields, the way that days of week or code share carriers are displayed, for example, can be modified to preference.

Additionally, the timetable can be solely nonstop and direct flights or can display multi hop connections. Data for the PDF Timetable Platform is processed electronically and imported to the Schedules part of the PDF.

The PDF generally includes three parts:

- Cover page
- Content pages
- Schedules

Each component part is merged in production into a single product. Each of the parts can be updated with each edition.

The Cover page and Content pages can include most any graphic, text or combination format.

Schedules Section display variables include:

- Font
- Spacing
- Font color
- Background color
- Column width
- Section separators

On each schedules page template there are display options:

- First/Last From/To City in header/footer
- 'Banner' ad in header/footer
- with internal PDF link
- with Web link
- Branding in header/footer
- Web link in header/footer
- Text/phone number/description in header/footer
- Skyscraper or similar ad/graphic placement

Destination based advertising can be tied to specified From or To cities:

- Font
- Font color
- Background color
